

**VERNON CITY COMMISSION
SPECIAL MEETING
JANUARY 12, 2015**

Mayor Pro-tem Pat Bryant called the Special Meeting of the Vernon City Commission to order at 3:33 p.m. in the Commission Chambers, and a quorum was declared present.

BENTLEY STREET CONSTRUCTION BIDS

City Manager Grant explained that this is an all concrete construction project, and the bids came in under budget. Construction will be paid with a grant, at no cost to the City.

Commissioner Hinojosa made the motion to approve the acceptance of bid for construction of Bentley Street between US 287 and Sullivan Street and approve construction contract subject to attorney review with bid alternate #2.

City Secretary Linda Byers brought attention to the job description and job posting provided in the packet, and asked for clarification on a salary range to advertise the job.


Commissioner Taylor made the motion to approve job description and authorize advertising for city manager position with a salary range of \$80,000 - \$110,000 depending upon education and experience.
