
The Roy Orbison Monument Project

A Plan to Place a Bronze Statue to Honor Roy Orbison at the Site of His Birth



Roy Orbison was born on April 23rd, 1936 at the Christ the King Hospital in downtown Vernon, Texas. For many years, the location of Orbison's birth went unmarked, despite the fact that Roy Orbison is widely acclaimed as one of the most influential musical artists of the late 20th century. We want to change that.

In 2013, community leaders in Vernon, Texas unveiled a sign to mark the location of the birth of this important artist, but we feel that a more impressive monument is needed to do justice to the memory of a person of Roy Orbison's stature.
