City of Vernon Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2018

The City of Vernon purchases natural gas from Atmos Energy. In Calendar Year 2018, the City purchased a total of 4345 thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from GEXA Energy.^[1] In calendar year 2018, the City purchased a total of 3,950,193 kilowatt hours.

The City purchases electricity from SWRE. In calendar year 2018, the city purchased a total of 858,764 kilowatt hours.

The City is a self-supplier of water. In calendar year of 2018, the City consumed a total of 4,084,000 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity, and water purchased by the City in the calendar year 2018 is \$ 494,045.41.
