Description

The Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer is under the direction of the Community Development Superintendent. The successful applicant will inspect commercial and residential construction projects, will review technical and construction documents, and will verify compliance with all codes, ordinances, standards and regulations and work Code Enforcement for the City of Vernon

Requirements

High School Diploma or GED equivalent and five (5) year's journeyman/foreman-level experience in building trades and electrical, mechanical, and plumbing installation; OR

Any equivalent combination of experience and training that provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

Certification as Building Inspector through the International Code Council, Electrical Inspector, State Plumbing Inspector License with a Med Gas Endorsement, or ICC Mechanical Inspector is preferred.

International Code Council (ICC) Inspector certifications are required within one year of hire.

Depending on the needs of the City, the incumbent may be required to obtain additional specific technical training and certifications.

Must pass a pre-employment drug screen, criminal background check, credit check, and MVR check.
